1. Why Halifax?

this far east, giving us a wonderful opportunity to explore this amazing part of our country! Attendees will also be able to enjoy the warm fellowship and hospitality of our Nova Scotia churches, who often are unable to participate in wider AGC activities. What a perfect way to encourage these churches and make connections in a truly beautiful location!

2. Who are our hosts?

We are excited to introduce Bridgewater Open Bible Church (Bridgewater, NS) and The Peoples Church (Truro, NS) as our conference hosts. These AGC member churches can't wait to welcome you to their province! They will be hosting us at Stoneridge Fellowship in Lower Sackville, NS, which is just 20 minutes' drive from Halifax airport.

3. What amount should we set aside in our budget?

- Plan on \$400 \$800 per person for round trip flights, depending on which airline you use. WestJet and Air Canada have direct flights from Hamilton, Toronto and Montreal, while smaller airports have flights available using discount airlines such as Swoop.
- We are working on group blocks for local hotels but expect a rate of \$180 220 per night for a double room.
- If you wish to rent a car at the airport, expect a rental price of \$150 300 for 3 days.

4. What are some local attractions?

Nova Scotia has many wonderful sites to visit! Here are just a few:

- Visit <u>Peggy's Cove</u> to see the iconic lighthouse. Less than an hours' drive from our conference venue!
- There is much to see in <u>downtown Halifax</u>, which is a short half hour drive.
- <u>Lunenburg's</u> distinctive waterfront and colourful buildings are worth the drive of just over an hour.
