Children of the Light

We're at the beginning of a brand-new year, but rather than focusing on some stereotypical New Year's theme, let's think instead on the topic of light. "Why this topic?" you may be asking.

Well, it's like this ... we've just come through the celebration of Advent, a time of waiting, followed by Christmas, a time of celebration of the birth of Christ Jesus our Lord, and now we're facing the deep dark days of winter - the time when all the festive lights are taken down, perhaps when we need their bright cheeriness the most.

The poem In the Bleak Midwinter by Christina Rossetti expresses how life can be in Canada during the long winter months. The haunting melody set to the lyrics can send chills down your spine. "Frosty wind made moan, earth stood hard as iron, water like a stone ... snow had fallen, snow on snow, snow on snow..."

Consider frosty, not in reference to temperature but in terms of the world's indifference to the message of hope that came in the form of the Christ child. Jesus, the light of the world became flesh so that He could illuminate the darkness, and bring warmth to each soul who puts their trust in Him. Jesus is the only true source of light. His Spirit can turn a person's cold indifference into a warm acceptance of His gift, so freely given. Once hearts as hard as iron are softened by the Spirit's gentle prompting, then the darkness vanishes, and "we are no longer people walking in darkness because the light has dawned" (Isaiah 9:2). When we receive God's gift of salvation, He fills our hearts with peace, joy, light, and love. Jesus said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life" (John 8:12).

No one wants to live in the shadow of darkness, yet so many do. God promises us something much better, "for He has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son He loves" (Col. 1: 13). This kingdom is a kingdom of light. Despite the dark days of winter, the chill, or the harshness of this world, we can, as followers of Jesus "walk in the light as He is in the light and have fellowship one with another" (1 John 1:7). So, we are to let our lights shine, and sincerely pray that in some small way, we may be that light that draws others to Jesus.

"For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light" (Ephesians 5:9).
