God is a God of Balance

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:6-8).

It seems to me that the God of peace is also the God of balance. I was sharing this thought with a friend one day and it brought her comfort.

What do I mean by the God of balance? During life's difficult circumstances, God seems to bring balance by providing a blessing too. Here is an example from my own experience. Years ago, my mother was in the hospital and our family anxiously waited for the results of a bone marrow test. The diagnosis was leukemia. I spent many hours with my mom, and it was a time of deep stress. So, I was surprised when I would fall asleep while praying at bedtime each night. Upon awakening one morning, I opened an e-mail and there was a newsletter update from my daughter who was serving the Lord in S.E. Asia. It was filled with encouragement and news that was a very definite answer to prayer. That's what I mean by our God being a God of balance. When discouraged, there is often a ray of sunshine to remind us that God is a loving faithful Father who cares deeply for His children. My mom passed away a short time later which was a hard thing, but God in His mercy brought me into a closer relationship with her as I helped with her care. There were lessons learned about love, so again out of sorrow came blessing.

The Apostle Paul exhorts us to rejoice in all circumstances and to be anxious for nothing. We must consciously decide not to dwell on the negative circumstances but to focus on the many times that God has proven faithful. How reassuring it is to know that God never changes, He never fails. He never goes back on His promises. "Know therefore that the Lord your God is God; He is the faithful God" (Deut. 7:9).

At times we may forget His faithfulness. When trials and testing come, it may seem as if God has surely forgotten us. It has been my experience that one doesn't have to wait very long to experience joy amid the tears or sunshine after the rain. That's what I mean by balance ... yes there is often bad news around the corner, but there's also good news. The good news is this ... we serve a Faithful God who is available to all who call upon Him.
